In keeping with Tara's tradition of inclusion and recognition of outstanding individuals, we are proud to offer a number of scholarships to cover part or full tuition as well as boarding fees to girls in both our Junior and Senior Schools.

SCHOLARSHIPS ON OFFER

Tara offers a number of scholarships, including Academic for girls entering Years 5, 7 and 9; All-Rounder for girls entering Years 5, 7 and 9; Music for girls entering Year 7; Tara Foundation (Means-Tested) for girls entering Year 7; and Boarding for girls entering Years 7-11. Girls must demonstrate strong academic performance, combined with a high degree of personal commitment and involvement in a range of leadership and co-curricular activities. Applicants for all scholarships are required to submit a portfolio and sit for the Edutest scholarship test, held on Saturday 11 March 2017. For some scholarships you will be asked to provide additional evidence of achievements or supporting documentation. Music candidates will be contacted and invited to attend an audition on Wednesday, 1 March 2017.
