

SCHOLARSHIPS ON OFFER

The King's School offers a number of Scholarships, primarily to boys entering Year 7, which take into consideration high-range academic results gained during testing (Edutest Pty Ltd conducts testing on site at the School) and demonstrated leadership potential in the creative and performing arts, sport and the community. Bursaries are also awarded, largely to country applicants for boarding places, and are means tested. Short-listed candidates will be invited to attend an interview to further their application and will be assessed on their ability and willingness to contribute to the co-curricular program of the School.
