SCHOLARSHIPS ON OFFER

Scholarships being offered in 2020, awarded at the Principal's discretion and providing for full or part remission of fees, include:

Academic Scholarships for entry into Year 7 and Year 10; awarded to a student or students who demonstrate academic excellence through success in the Scholarship Test held at Wenona on Friday 1 March, 2019, and interviews which follow.

Boarding Scholarships for entry into any of Years 7 to Year 11: awarded to a student or students who demonstrate a commitment to their studies, as well as extra-curricular and community involvement. Boarding Scholarship applicants are also required to sit the Scholarship Test held at Wenona on Friday 1 March, 2019. Short-listed applicants will be interviewed.

Music Scholarships for entry into Year 7; awarded to a student or students who demonstrate strong musical ability reflected in their technical proficiency, sense of musicality and stylistic interpretation of their repertoire at audition. Music Scholarship applicants are also required to attend an audition held at Wenona's Independent Theatre on Friday 8 February, 2019 and sit the Scholarship Test held at Wenona on Friday 1 March, 2019.
